

# Mail Order Pharmacy Program Excluded Drug List

**For MassHealth, Commonwealth Care, Connector Care/Qualified Health Plan, Employer Choice & Commonwealth Choice members**

The drugs or drug categories listed below are **not** available through our mail order program. Check the drug list on the website for a list of medications that can be filled by mail, which includes most maintenance medications.

- **Non-maintenance drugs, including:**

- Acne products
- Antibiotics
- Antidiarrheals
- Anti-nausea/vomiting medications
- Anti-fungal medications
- Antihistamines
- Certain Analgesics (e.g. Tramadol)
- Certain Topical Medications
- Corticosteroids
- Migraine medications

- **Specialty drugs, including:**

- Anti-hemophilic agents
- Biologic DMARDs (e.g. Enbrel, Remicade)
- Growth Hormones
- Hepatitis C drugs
- Immune Globulins
- Multiple Sclerosis drugs
- Pulmonary Arterial Hypertension drugs

- **Most over-the-counter drugs, excluding:**

- Proton-Pump Inhibitors (e.g. Prilosec OTC)

- **All new-to-market medications**

- **All controlled substances, including:**

- ADD/ADHD Medications
- Benzodiazepines
- Fentanyl (e.g. Actiq, Fentora)
- Hydromorphone
- Morphine sulphate (e.g. Avinza, Kadian)
- Oxycodone
- Suboxone, Subutex

- **All drugs listed as benefit exclusion, including:**

- Dietary and nutritional supplements
- Drugs used for cosmetic purposes
- Drugs used for sexual dysfunction
- Experimental or investigational drugs
- Medical foods
- Weight loss drugs

- **Miscellaneous drugs**

- Anticoagulants (e.g. warfarin, Pradaxa)
- Gabapentin
- Muscle relaxants

- **Blood Glucose Testing Supplies**

## Other Important Information

- Before you can use the BMC HealthNet Plan mail order drug program, you must have filled a 30-day supply of each medication, two times at a retail pharmacy within the previous 3 months.
